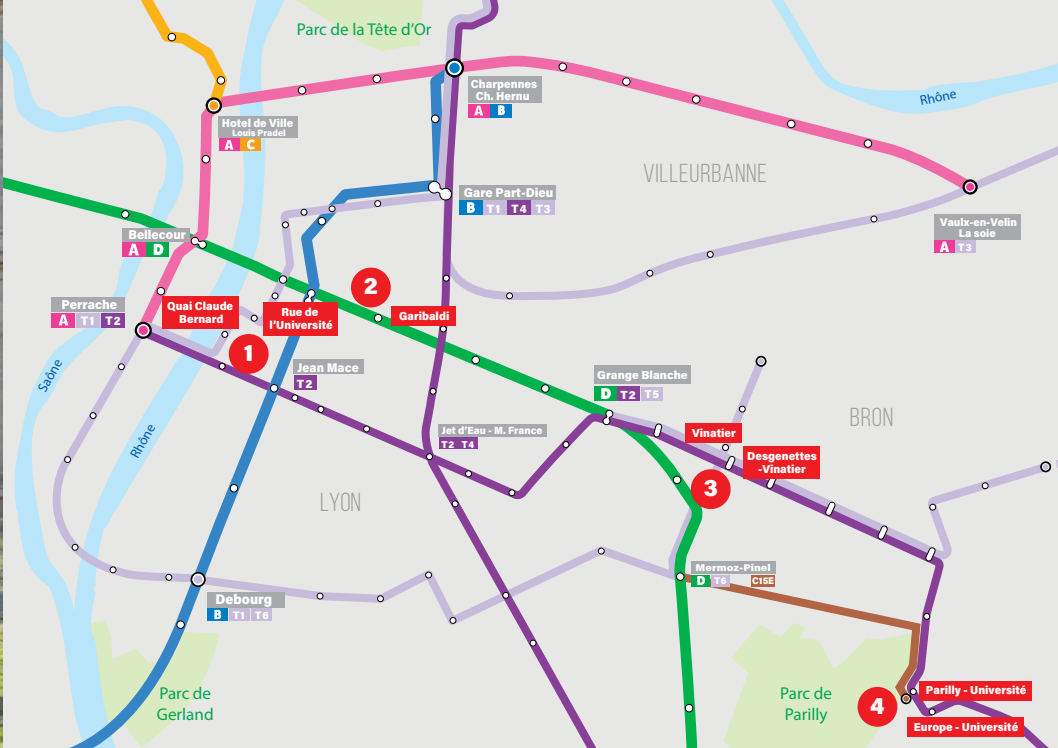

STUDENT HEALTH SERVICE (SSE)

The SSE offers consultations by a multidisciplinary team on the BDR and PDA campuses from Monday to Friday, **by appointment only**. These services complement those provided by community doctors and hospitals.

Free consultations :

nursing, dietetics, psychology, prevention check-ups, health check-ups for international students, Smoking cessation support, health mediation, accommodation for students with disabilities, etc.

Paid consultations :

(sector 1 with third-party payment of the mandatory part) general medicine, gynaecology and nursing care, and more.

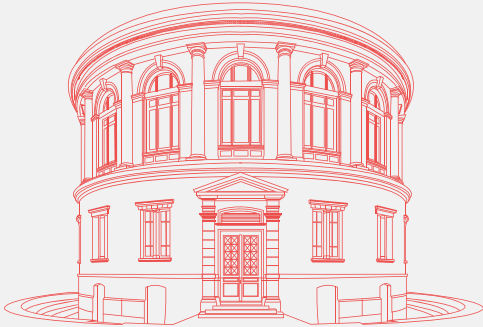

SPORT

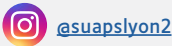

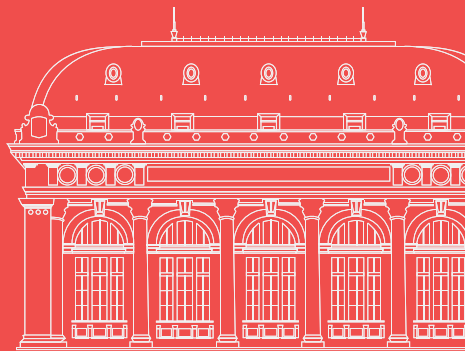

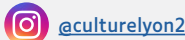
CULTURE

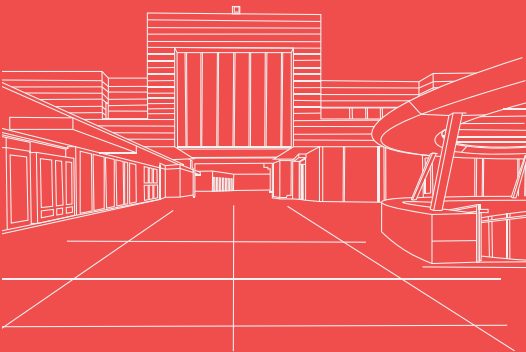
