### Description of thesis subject

The BAUHAUS4EU European alliance comprises 10 universities in 9 European countries, and has set itself the goal of developing a joint campus on a European scale. The BAUHAUS4EU project includes a commitment to develop joint doctoral programmes at alliance level, in line with the needs of territories in terms of resilience and sustainability. The candidate will be expected to demonstrate that his or her doctorate is in line with this approach. To this end, the candidate will represent Lumière Lyon 2 on the Alliance's PhD Council.
